

(b) Dead coppice stools in a post-WWII spruce plantation, Kellenberg area (Wiehengebirge). (c) State-owned beech high forest, strict forest reserve “Großer Freeden” (Teutoburg Forest). (d) Private former coppice stand that has been developed towards a high-forest structure by the promotion of only one sprout per coppice stool, Spannbrink area (Teutoburg Forest).
